Hands in the Community Highlights of 2010

(Numbers in parentheses are from 2009)

1. **648 people were helped** (325)
2. **21 projects - Roof repairs, home repairs, painting, fencing, yard work** (10 projects)
3. **66 office volunteers** (51)
4. **Over 125 businesses that donated services/materials** (35)
5. **20 church partners** (12)
6. **1473 total volunteers available in the community** (793)
7. **Provided drinks/snacks to after school bible clubs - 28**
8. **Provided \$1,641,000 of goods/services - 2800% investment** (almost \$500,000 - 2500%)
9. **Provided computers/office equipment to Boys/Girls Club**
10. **Provided furniture/appliances to families**
11. **Increased the number of professionals who offered their services (i.e. physicians, dentists, oral surgeons, plumbers, electricians, general contractors)**
12. **Established Senior Care program - gave away electric wheel chairs, scooters, lift chairs**

Goals & Objectives for 2011

Urgent Needs

This is an overview of AMP Ministries which holds the non-profit 501 (c) 3:

Hands in the Community (HNC) - over 1689 volunteers through 20 churches (generated \$140,000.00 of goods/services in Tulare County each month)

Kids 4 the King - 28 on campus after school Bible clubs in Tulare county - ministering to over 1,200 students in grades 1-6

Sons of Hope - assisting young men 16-24 to help them get out of gangs and be contributors back into their respective communities

Beyond the Fence - providing support/resources for people with disabilities and assisting parents with children who are disabled

Senior Care - providing medical assistance, supplies or equipment and a unique group of individuals who share compassion for the elderly

Internship program - providing high school, Jr. college, and college students with community service credits, along with hands on experience in an office environment
