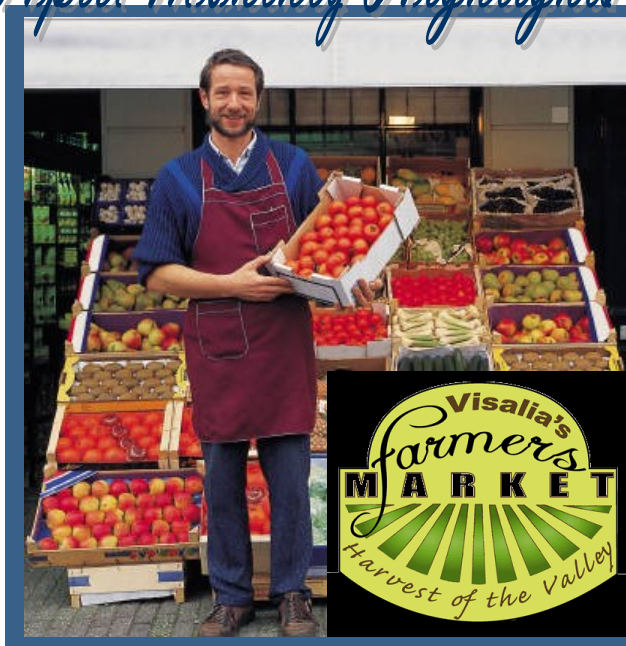

### HelpingHands

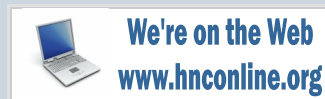
#### Succeeding in our Mission:
